The CSIR NET is an examination of national importance that is held to determine the eligibility of candidates for the role of Junior Research Fellowship in government Public Sector Units (PSUs) as well as for the position of assistant professor/lectureship (LS) in government universities. This competitive exam takes place twice a year, in the months of June and December.
